

Privacy Policy

Effective as of September 1, 2021

This Privacy Policy applies to the website and all other online properties (“*Site*”) operated by Art Dock LLC and our affiliates (“*Art Dock*”, “*we*”, or “*us*”). The use of the Site, including the purchase of any classes or services (“*Services*”) and other offline communications, is subject to the following privacy policy (“*Privacy Policy*”). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By using this Site, you agree to this Privacy Policy as well as any other terms, guidelines or rules that apply to any portion of this Site, without limitation or qualification. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, then you must exit the Site immediately and discontinue any use of the information obtainable or accessible through the Site. I. COLLECTED INFORMATION

This Privacy Policy explains how Art Dock may collect, use, and disclose Personal Information (defined below) we obtain through the Site, your communications with us, or from third parties. “*Personal Information*” means information that alone or when in combination with other information may be used to readily identify, contact, or locate you, such as: name, address, email address, or phone number. We do not consider Personal Information to include information that has been anonymized such that it does not allow a third party to easily identify a specific individual.

Art Dock may collect both Personal Information and browsing information from you. Such information may include:

- **Passive Collection.** Art Dock collects and stores information that is generated automatically as you use it, including your preferences and anonymous usage statistics. This information may include Internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, the files viewed on our site (e.g., HTML pages, graphics, etc.), operating system, date/time stamp, and/or clickstream data.
- **Tracking Technologies.** Art Dock and its partners use cookies, pixels, server logs, and other similar technology to analyze trends, administer the website, track users’ movements around the website, and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. You can control the use of cookies at the individual browser level, but if you choose to disable cookies, it may limit your use of certain features or functions on our website or service.

We may share your information, including Personal Information, for various purposes, including without limitation: (i) with vendors, consultants and other service providers who need access to such information to carry out work on our behalf; (ii) in response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with any applicable law, regulation or legal process or as otherwise required by any applicable law, rule or regulation; (iii) if we believe your actions are inconsistent with our user agreements or policies or to protect the rights, property and safety of us or any third party; (iv) in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing or transfer of all or a portion of our business to another company; (v) by publicly posting, at our discretion, your submissions, reviews, or other user content if you provide one; (vi) with your consent or at your direction; and (vii) promoting our services and the services of our affiliates and trusted business partners as permitted by applicable privacy law.
